Please, arrive on time for appointments. If you are more than 15 minutes late, we may ask you to reschedule for another time.

Because, our doctors want to honor your time and we try to stay on schedule for all our patients.

Please, if you are going to miss an appointment, let us know.

Because, this will allow us to give your appointment to someone else who needs to be seen. Three No Shows in a row may cause you to lose health center scheduling privileges.

Please, bring insurance information and co-pay to each visit. Let us know of any changes in address, or phone number.

Because, we want to make sure we can locate you with test results and that your bill is accurate/timely.

Please, bring ALL of your medicines, or a medicine list to every visit.

Because, this will reduce the possibility of drug interactions, and improve your care. We will review them at every visit.

Please, take an active role in your health care. Feel free to ask questions.

Because, our doctors want to be your partner in health care. Being an active participant will improve your overall health outcome.

Scheduling

It is our goal to accommodate your needs and requests. If you are ill, we reserve some same day appointments from 10-12 each day.

Medicine Refills

Routine medicine refills will be completed by the end of the next business day. Be sure to leave the name and number of your pharmacy.

On-call

After hours, a non-urgent message can be left for us by calling the office and selecting the proper voice mail box. If you have a severe Emergency, go to the closest Emergency Department. They can contact your doctor if needed. For minor emergencies, one of our doctors is always on call. The on-call doctor will NOT refill any medicine.
